A VERY BUSY 12 MONTHS! GOD CONTINUES TO OPEN DOORS!

So now in addition to New Prague and Savage TreeHouse locations....the Shakopee TreeHouse opened in late September 2022, we hosted three in-school support groups in the 2022-23 school year...in Jordan Middle School, Hidden Oaks & Twin Oaks Middle Schools in Prior Lake. Just this past week, June 22nd, we opened the new Prior Lake TreeHouse at St. Michaels Catholic Church Coffee House. We were super excited to welcome 5 new students! The Well TreeHouse Network is serving over 130 students across Scott County! In addition, we have partnered with Scott County via a grant, to provide two full-time Truancy coordinators that work to keep students 7th—12th grade in school. More details on next page...

P.A.T.H. (Promoting Attendance Through Hope) Program! Welcome Sara & Cherry!

The Well TreeHouse Network partnered with Scott County in April 2022 to assist with the growing problem of teens not attending school. Scott County was seeking a different approach to help and TreeHouse has had a very positive track record over the past several years in helping teens by providing support, mentoring, love and encouragement. The Well received grant funding from Scott County to employ a PATH Coordinator. Sara Bernard of Prior Lake was hired and Sara took off with the idea. created and implemented a successful truancy approach that uses the TreeHouse model as part of the program. Sara visited schools across Scott County during the school year, meets with parents and students, provides resources, and goes the extra mile to get teens back in school.

This past April, The Well was awarded additional funds to hire an additional PATH Coordinator to assist Sara and the county truancy team. Cherry Wilson of Savage, MN was hired and began her duties on June 15th, 2023!

During the summer months, both ladies will work on outreach and mentoring students with the goal of a positive start to the start of school this fall. The reasons for teens not wanting to go to school range from being bullied, specific learning disabilities, depression and anxiety, refusal to get out of bed or get dressed, transportation, social phobias, and so many more.

The Well Afterschool Program!

As the summer slips by, we are thinking about the future of our afterschool program hours that would begin again when school starts. This program is geared to meet the needs of parents that have a student in 6th—9th grade and would rather their student not be home alone afterschool unsupervised or maybe just needs a positive social outlet. The program provides a safe place for your student to hang out after school, have a snack, homework assistance if needed plus a positive, encouraging environment that is definitely not boring, We have plenty to keep them busy such as an arcade room, gaming systems, ping pong, air hockey, board games, structured programming such as seasonal crafts, art therapy, bracelet making, and life skills programming. Plus, the center is well supervised.

Overcoming the Transportation Barrier!

For many families, transportation to attend TreeHouse programs is difficult, sometimes impossible. From day one, we have strived to provide transportation to & from support group at all locations. The ministry owns three vans that are being used across Scott County. Our Shakopee TreeHouse is our biggest challenge, we are at capacity with one van. Over the past several months of searching; we discovered that 12-15 passenger vans (used with somewhat low miles) were impossible to find. **But with God, nothing is impossible!** We, unexpectantly found a 2020 Chevy Express, 15 passenger van in Belle Plaine...became our latest purchase. We took a huge leap of faith...now to pay for it. This van will serve the New Prague-Jordan-Montgomery area on Mondays, the Shakopee area on Tuesdays, Prior Lake on Thursdays!

The Well Ministries has been serving teens since September 2017! What began as an after school drop-in center has evolved into our presence in six cities across Scott County. When we partnered with TreeHouse, Inc. of Minneapolis, MN in Feb 2018...we knew that God had plans for so much more. Visions came, doors were opened and we are thriving with four physical TreeHouse locations (+ 3 in-school groups). Each of those sites host programs that give teens a safe space to find support and belonging. Plus, through mentorships, retreats, and other off-site activities, teens have the opportunity to build even deeper relationship with peers and caring, compassionate adults.

Teens are a vital part of every community. Hopelessness is becoming a defining story of this generation. That's why we are on a mission to end hopelessness among teens. We offer grace-based programs and environments where teen learn to know a loving God, build resiliency, develop healthy relationships, and plan for the future. We strive for every teen to be rooted in the living hope of Jesus—unleashing untold potential in communities everywhere.


